

Water-based **Epoxy Primer (Grey)**

Tested to resist hydrostatic pressures of **5 bar = 50 metres** of water pressure negative (from underneath) & positive (from above). Most concrete has hydrostatic pressure.

It blocks rising damp in walls & flooring & blocks out efflorescence in concrete & corrosion in metal. It sticks like glue to many surfaces.

Can be used in damp areas because it continues to cure in water.



1. **Add powder to make a Repair Paste** - (we give mix ratio)
Fill cracks & holes & coat over soon after.

2. **Can be sculptured**

Add Mortar, Powder Filler & pebbles, then shape it to repair chunks of missing concrete or make ramps, strong enough to withstand forklifts. Coat within hours. (Can add Crusher Dust + cement to bulks it up).



3. **Self-Leveller**

Add sand & squeegee as a self-leveller over large areas of damaged concrete. This repair can also be coated in hours.



4. **Roll Crushed Glass In**

Lightly broadcast then back-roll crushed glass into Epoxy Primer. This adds tremendous strength & is a cheap way to bulk up your coating. No need to put crushed glass in the top coat & you will still have a nice anti-slip, depending on the size crushed glass you use in the Epoxy Primer.



Our Epoxy Primer is unusual because-

Add sand and it becomes a easy to use self leveller, to repair damaged concrete floors. Also when you broadcast crushed glass into our Epoxy Primer, it **HOLDS** the glass particles very well, bulking up & strengthening the top Coat.

Mix Ratio of our Epoxy Primers:-

WB ReadyToUse Epoxy Primer – 1:1 no water dilution

1 Lt Part A + 1 Lt Part B Coverage rate - ± 4.5 m²/Lt

WATERPROOFING - Two+ coats Epoxy Primer & minimum two coats Waterproofing Membrane.
